

Hobart Township Meeting
February 9, 2010

Present: Terry Hockett, Ray Sonnenberg, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Brian Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Bev Hockett, and Jim Ulteig.

Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the January 2010 minutes. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the treasurer's report.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Old Business discussed was the date of the Board of Review, date of March monthly meeting, date of annual meeting and canvassing of the votes.

New business discussed was: gravel and mowing quotes will expire in May, clerk is to get a minimum of two quotes; disabilities grant, which the Township will not be applying for; EOT Assoc meeting to be held on Monday, March 1, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. at Thumper Pond in Ottertail; short course to be held in Moorhead on March 29, 2010; the annual Firemen's meeting to be held at the fire hall on February 22, 2010. The Board will also be thinking of a date for the reorganization meeting, which cannot be held before March 17, 2010.

Discussion was held regarding the Zoning Ordinance which had been in effect from 1965 until 1992. Ulteig, MN DOT, stated that he was there to inform the Board that he will be denying some billboard applications along Highway 10 due to the fact that his research indicated that the Ordinance was still in effect, that it had not been properly repealed in 1992. After much discussion, R Sonnenberg made a motion to pass a resolution to place a moratorium on off premise signs and billboards for one year to obtain legal opinion as to whether or not the Ordinance is in effect and how to proceed to either change it or repeal it. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Hockett stated that he had received a letter from Douglas Blue regarding property on Wymer Lake regarding an issue they had with Land and Resource Management. Moltzan will write a letter to Blue answering his questions.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
