

Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
March 8, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Terry Hockett. Present were Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Brian Glawe and Debi Moltzan.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes with one correction. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the treasurer's report.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on validity of the zoning ordinance. According to the attorney, the zoning ordinance is still in effect. Consensus of the Board was to find all ordinances that were made by former Boards, forward them to the attorney and have him advise the Board on how to either bring them up to date or repeal them.

The reorganization meeting was scheduled for March 18, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall.

Discussion was held regarding dust guarding the roads. A quote was received from the Becker County Highway Department and Stenger's Dust Control. The Board told Clerk Moltzan to send a letter to Stenger to find out what type and what percentage the solution is that he uses; when he would be able to spread the dust control and how much advance notice he would give the Board. The letter would include a request for him to attend the next monthly meeting.

The Board reviewed the agenda for the annual meeting.

Jeff Stabnow presented the Board with a proposal for the engineering work for the East Lake 7 Road. Stabnow explained what could and should be done to reconstruct the road. Much discussion was held on the road improvement and consensus of the Board was to have Stabnow inquire and obtain any necessary permits. Stabnow also stated that if the work done exceeded his quote, the additional work would be billed at an hourly rate. D Sonnenberg made a motion to allow Stabnow to proceed in engineering the road construction and obtain necessary permits. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett made a motion to adjourn.
