

Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
June 8, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Terry Hockett. Present were: Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Brian Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Delta Daggett, Joe Stenger, Torey Sonnenberg, Jeff Stabnow, and Mr. Manning from Lakes Manning Paving.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2010 meeting. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 1, 2010 road meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the Treasure's report.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Delta Daggett stated that he was following up on the Otta Seal project. Much discussion was held on the number of landowners that would be in agreement to the project, funding, existing condition of the road and time line for possible work on the road. Daggett stated that he would continue pursuing the issue and do more research.

Manning's Lakes Paving submitted a proposal for patching the tar on the Camp Cherith Road. R Sonnenberg stated that there is one more proposal being submitted, but had not yet been received. Consensus of the Board was that action would be taken once the second proposal was received.

Edna Township had contacted Hockett and requested an estimate for graveling 460<sup>th</sup> St before the work was done. The Board would contact Edna with an estimate.

Jeff Stabnow gave an update on the Lake 7 road project. The consensus of the Board was that they were to meet June 21, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. on the Lake 7 Road to discuss the next course of action on the road and prepare a quote sheet for the remainder of the work to be done.

R Sonnenberg stated that a meeting has been set with the Township Attorney for June 18, 2010 at 9:00 am.

Discussion was held regarding a possible website for the Township. R Sonnenberg made a motion to look into the cost and maintenance for setting up a website. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Frazer Fire contract was discussed. The Board felt that signing a three year contract with so many variables was giving the City and Fire Department a blank check. The

clerk was to send another letter to the City of Frazee stating the Board would not sign a three year contract and to invite a representative from the City and/or Fire Department to attend the next regular Township Meeting.

D Sonnenberg stated that he has been contacted regarding properties with possible noxious weeds. D Sonnenberg made a motion to place a notice in the paper reminding residents to control the noxious weeds and to set up weed spraying for the Township. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding the owners of the cabin known as "Canadian Cove" turning over a portion of their lot as road right of way in hopes to correct their impervious lot coverage issue. Consensus of the Board was that they would accept the road dedication, but would not pay for the acquisition.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
