

Hobart Township Meeting  
July 13, 2010

Present: Terry Hockett, Ray Sonnenberg, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Brian Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Jeff Stabnow, Marv Heisler and Joe Stenger.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Hockett.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2010 meeting. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the Treasurer's report.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Stabnow discussed the quote that would be sent out to contractors for the work to be done on the East Lake Seven Road. It was suggested that the gravel portion of the quote be taken out of the quote since Heisler's Gravel has the gravel contract with the Township. A stipulation that proper signage must be put up during construction will be added to the quote. Changes would be made to the quote sheet, mailed out to contractors. R Sonnenberg made a motion for the Board to reconvene on Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. to go over the quotes and finish other business that comes before the Board between now and the 27<sup>th</sup>. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding the culvert by Schmid's driveway and the fact that it needs to be flushed out, and work to be done in that area to divert water to prevent the road from washing out again. Discussion was held regarding rip rap along the bridge between Wymer and Graham Lakes. D Sonnenberg would look into what it would take to correct these problem areas.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve a resolution appointing election judges. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to change the August meeting from August 10, 2010 to August 9, 2010 due to the primary elections. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

At this time, Chairman Hockett recessed the meeting until Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting reconvened Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Terry Hockett, Ray Sonnenberg, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Brian Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Jeff Stabnow, Marv Heisler, Doug Ackling, Torey Sonnenberg, Jeff Stabnow, Joe Stenger,

Ron and Linda Franklin and Tom Franklin.

Hockett made a motion to approve the disbursements received since the last meeting. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Tarring quotes for the fix up spots on Camp Cherith Road were discussed. Two quotes were received, one from Performance Paving and Manning Lakes Paving. Discussion was held regarding the work performance of both companies and the price difference in quotes. D Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the quote from Performance Paving based on the fact that their quote was the lowest. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

A quote was received from Brock White for the matting to be used on the Lake Seven Road project. The price was for the same mat used on the other road projects. R Sonnenberg made a motion to order the matting from Brock White based on the fact that they have supplied the Township with the matting used for all the rest of the road projects. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Ron and Linda Franklin approached the Board about taking over the maintenance for Petal Drive on Rose Lake. The property is being sold, the property split up, cabin being removed and Franklin's are to be taking over the easement. They would like to turn the easement into a Township Road, however, there may not be enough room for a cul-de-sac and the road is approximately 200 ft in length. Discussion was held regarding what would have to be done to make it a Township Road, which would include the easement being described as either an easement for public road purposes or to a dedicated public road, width of the easement, upgrading the road at Franklin's expense, to meet the Township specifications as best possible for that location. Once the exact location of the roadway is known, Franklin will contact the Board Members so that they can tour the road and discuss what Franklin needs to do to improve the road.

Two quotes were received for the reconstruction of E Lake Seven Road. One quote was received from Joe Stenger and one quote from Sonnenberg/Jutz Excavating. Discussion was held regarding the quotes. Stabnow compared the quotes and explained the differences. There is approximately a \$6,000 difference in the quotes. D Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the quote from Joe Stenger to do the proposed work on the East Lake Seven Road due to the fact that his quote was the lowest. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

At this time, Tom Franklin joined the meeting and stated that he was in favor of the Township taking over Petal Drive. The Board explained that they discussed things with Ron Franklin and are working with him on that possibility.

Discussion was held regarding the location of the Gorman/Edna/Hobart Town lines. There seems to be a discrepancy that needs to be resolved. R Sonnenberg made a motion to hire a surveyor to find the boundaries where these Townships meet. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was also held regarding other road projects that need to be done as a result of all the rain. It was the consensus of the Board that the Board should invest in erosion control mat to have on hand in case of future problems.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
