

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
September 14, 2010**

Present: Kathy Glawe, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Terry Hockett, Ray Sonnenberg, Debi Moltzan, Jeff Stabnow, Torey Sonnenberg, Marv Heisler, Jerry Wallin and Joe Stenger.

Chairman Terry Hockett called the meeting was called to order at 7:20 p.m.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the August 9,2010 minutes. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Jerry Walling questioned when the cover would be placed on the culvert by his property, otherwise everything is working well with all the rain. R Sonnenberg stated that the cover was on order and should be here soon.

Stabnow gave a progress report on the E Lake 7 Road. There were 4 rolls of fabric left over from the road project, which will be kept for future projects. Discussion was held on finishing of an end slope in a portion of the road. Since this location has not had previous snow problems, it was the consensus of everyone to leave this area alone and not cut further back into the hill and disturb the sugar sand.

R. Sonnenberg gave an update on the tarring projects. R Sonnenberg also stated that the Township should be obtaining copies of DOT inspections of all equipment used by contractors in the Township along with a copy of their health cards and a copy of the liability insurance for the City of Vergas.

Discussion was held regarding the graveling of the Gorman/Hobart line road. More gravel is needed on the north side of the hill by Rodney Flatau's property. Discussion was held regarding the graveling of the Candor/Hobart line road. Rocking of the culvert between Wymer and Graham Lakes is to begin. Heisler and T Sonnenberg are to haul in rock for one day, then the Supervisors will evaluate the project to see how much more rock is needed.

Discussion was held regarding the information received from Nate Welte regarding the Zoning Ordinance. It was the consensus of the Board to have Welte come to the next meeting.

Stabnow discussed having the town roads described and recorded. Stabnow will prepare an estimate for the Board.

Discussion was held regarding the creation of a Township website. Moltzan will work with Jan Eitzen on setting one up and maintaining the site. Moltzan stated that the site will be setup so that she or future clerks will have the control of the updating.

R Sonnenberg gave an update of the fire department and now removal of the fire hall property.

Discussion was held regarding the County approval of Kent Adams plat on Rose Lake and the current condition of the road. The Board stated that the road will not be taken over until the road meets the Township's criteria and the County's stipulation that the in slopes are to be 3:1 ratio.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
