

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
December 14, 2010**

Present: Kathy Glawe, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Terry Hockett, and Debi Moltzan.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 2010 meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the treasurer's report.

R Sonnenberg gave a report on the meeting regarding the joint powers for the ambulance service, which nothing will happen until March 2011 and each entity will have one representative.

D Sonnenberg stated that Becker County will not be plowing the section of road from the Becker County line to the Wymer Lake Road. Hobart Township will have to assume the maintenance on that section of road. Further discussion was held regarding the snow plowing policy, change in road maintenance, and location of the majority of residents. Hockett made a motion to change the snow plowing policy to allow the snow removal of the northerly portion of the Township, primarily the Wymer Lake area, first due to the fact that the majority of the population is in that area. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.,

Discussion was held regarding the 'old road' on Kermit Schultz's land located in Section 20. The status is not known and several people have approached Board members on what the current status of this road is. Consensus of the Board was to have Jeff Stabnow research the status of the road.

Discussion was held regarding a sign resolution with the County for purchasing the new signs. Consensus of the Board was to have the company hired to install the signs to purchase the signs.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
