

**Hobart Township Meeting
June 14, 2011**

Present: Kathy Glawe, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Terry Hockett, Debi Moltzan, Torey Sonnenberg, Marv Heisler, Art Sazama, Ken Schwartzrock, Jeff Stabnow, Joe Stenger, Bob Shelstad, Paul Pinke, Kris Whalen, Stephanie Hogan and Ralph Teckmeyer.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 2011 meeting. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the Treasurer's report. D Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Paul Pinke was present to discuss the recycling area within the City of Vergas. Pinke stated that the City would like the four surrounding townships to cost share the expense of maintaining the recycling area. Pinke stated that one of the city councilmen wanted to close the brush/leaf area to everyone except the city residents, but other members wanted to contact the area townships one more time. Consensus of the Board was that they could not make a decision tonight because one Board member was absent.

Kris Whalen questioned why the flood gate had not been installed on the culvert by their house. T Sonnenberg stated that the gate had to be ordered and made because the prebuilt ones were too expensive. T Sonnenberg further stated that he has just been contacted that the gate is done. T Sonnenberg will pick up the gate and get it installed. Whalen stated that they have been pleased with the Township's cooperation in fixing their water problem.

Art Sazama and Ralph Teckmeyer were present to discuss a road agreement and discuss road maintenance. The Board reminded them that Hobart and Gorman had a written road agreement that was done in 2006 and a copy was given to them.

Stephanie Hogan questioned the Board as to what they were going to do about her lawn, which is not mowable after the road construction on East Lake Seven Road. Stabnow stated that the area could be raked to be smoothed, black dirt added if needed and seeded.

Bob Shelstad questioned why their request for dust guard was not done. The Board explained that none of the roads have been done and that the area requested on Adam's Point Road will be done. Discussion was also held regarding the frost boils between County Rd 4 and the public access. Stabnow stated that there is a way to dig out the muck and lay mat without totally shutting down the road. D Sonnenberg made a motion to allow Stabnow to continue with fixing the frost boil in Adam's Point Road between

County Road 4 and the public access. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held as to when dust guard would be applied. Consensus was that as soon as all the roads are in shape, Stenger will begin dust guarding.

Ken Schwartzrock addressed the Board about the grading on East Rose Lake Road. Schwartzrock stated that he, along with other residents on the road, are not happy with the grading and something needs to be changed. Discussion was held. The engineer and blade maintainer will review the situation and make necessary changes.

Stabnow gave an update on the East Wymer Lake Road project and stated that the water level has not changed so a culvert may not be necessary.

Discussion was held regarding the letter sent to Mikula about the dangerous approach installed and Mikula's response. Mikula stated that he would be willing to buy warning signs. Hockett stated that he and Steve Bruhn visited the site well over 6 years ago and felt at that time the proposed location was dangerous and approval was never given. Stabnow stated that signage would not help the problem and that the approach should be removed. The clerk will contact Mikula with this information.

Discussion was held on Summer Short Course, setting a meeting date for the public hearing for repealing the ordinances and recording the road. D Sonnenberg and Glawe will be attending the Short Course. Consensus of the Board was to set the public hearing for August 9, 2011 before the regular meeting. D Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the resolution /notice of public hearing for both the road recording and ordinance repealing. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting at 8:50 p.m.
