

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
October 11, 2011**

**Present:** All board members along with 13 constituents.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the September 2011 minutes with minor corrections. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe gave the Treasurer's report. D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

George Massey addressed the Board with concerns about the creditability of Huston Engineering's report and stated that he did not want his tax dollars to fund this project. Massey felt that the water ways are being restricted by debris and silt and that the waterways and culverts should be cleaned.

Neil Strawhorne, Loon Lake, wanted to go on record that he had been misquoted at the last meeting. Strawhorne stated that he had said 'there would be zero impact downstream if the control gate was set at the present flow of 15 feet per second'.

Further discussion was held regarding the creditability of the report, application process, comment period, if the project would be done and who is in charge of maintenance of the CORP's waterway.

Comments from the Board included that the comment period of the application would determine whether or not the report is creditable; the steps needed to be taken once DNR makes their decision about the permit and the fact that Houston Engineering was not present at the last meeting to present their study report.

Ken Schwartzrock and Cory Nyhus, both from Rose Lake, were present to give an update on the zebra mussels found in Rose Lake, the course of action to eliminate them and what could be done to prevent further spreading.

Kent Adams presented his final plat to the Board for approval and asked that the Board take over the maintenance of the road. After review of the information presented to the Board, R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the final plat and to take over maintenance of Adam's Point Trail based on the fact that it meets the criteria. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Zoning Ordinance was once again discussed. It appears that the public hearing will

have to be re-held due to the fact that the notice reflected the 1971 ordinance, which had not been adopted, not the original 1965 ordinance. D Sonnenberg made a motion to repeat the repealing process and set the hearing date for November 8, 2011 at 7:00 pm. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The approach permit and policy was reviewed. R Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the approach permit and policy as presented. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting at 8:45 p.m.
