

**Continuation Meeting of Hobart Township
Continued from November 13, 2011**

Present: Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Kathy Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Pam Jenkins, and Jeff Stabnow.

Hockett reconvened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Uf Da Vista road was discussed. The road is a dedicated public road as dedicated in the plat of Herb's Ridge, but currently is not maintained by the Township. Before the Township could even consider taking over the maintenance of this road, the large sink hole on the north side of the road . The owner of Lot 7 is to be contacted to remove the brush from the cul-de-sac. The brush needs to be removed, not burnt. If the brush is not hauled away, the Township will hire someone to remove the brush and either bill the owner or assess it to the taxes. Should the owner go ahead and burn the brush pile anyway, the ashes would need to be dug out, disposed of properly and the road reconstructed at this location before the Township would take over the maintenance.

Discussion was held regarding the road specifications being outdated and should be updated. Stabnow will update the specifications and submit to the Board for approval.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to place a moritorium on taking over the maintenance of new roads until the policy is in place. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Further discussion was held regarding the past practice of paying the winter road maintainer a minimum of \$1,000 per winter months. A written policy was not found so Moltzan and Stabnow wrote a resolution for a minimum payment of \$1,000 per winter month plus the cost of sand, salt and other materials needed. R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the resolution. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
