

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting**  
**April 9, 2013**

Present: Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Kathy Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Rich McCrady, Jeff Stabnow, Ray Sazama and Torey Sonnenberg.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:20 p.m.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the agenda with additions. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 2013 meeting and reorganization meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Hockett made a motion to approve the final wording of the road specifications as previously approved. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

McCrady gave a building committee update. The committee as a whole has not met since the annual meeting, however, McCrady has had discussions with BHH regarding what their fees would be to continue with furnishing the specification for the bidding process and completing the bidding process. McCrady also suggested getting other people involved with other aspects of the project, including additional people on the building committee to avoid any potential conflicts of interest. After much discussion, Hockett made a motion and D Sonnenberg second to:

1. Obtain a certificate of indebtedness for \$250,000 for a period of ten (10) years to complete the construction, of which the levied taxes will be collected over a period of seven (7) years,
2. Go ahead of the outside bidding process to avoid any potential conflict of interests,
3. Begin ground work and remove/relocate tress as soon as the weather allows;
4. Obtain two (2) quotes for the well, septic system and site preparation.

Snowplowing quotes were discussed. Hockett made a motion to obtain two (2) quotes for snow plowing, one from Ray Sazama and one from Sonnenberg Road Maintenance. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Previously approved service agreements and resolutions were reviewed and signed, along with the liquor license for Spanky's.

Dustguard quotes will be obtained for the next meeting. Lake View Township will be

contacted to check the roads for crack sealing.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting at 9:00 p.m.
