

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting
December 10, 2013**

Present: Kathy Glawe, Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Debi Moltzan, Jeff Stabnow and Bev Hockett.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The agenda was considered and one item was added to the agenda, Fire Board update. Hockett made a motion to approve the amended agenda. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Minutes from the November meetings. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the bills as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried. A late addition to the bills was received from RMS for weed spraying and R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the addition of this bill to be paid this month. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Construction of the town hall was discussed. The Board is disappointed with the progress being made, it appears that the hall will not be completed by the contract date. Moltzan is to contact both Bristlin and Son Construction and BHH to relay the Board's disapproval.

Seal coating of road was discussed. Discussion included the additional fog coat during the seal coating process and additional costs. Stabnow stated that the TWP could go out for bids with other surrounding TWPs instead of going through the County, which may be cheaper. Stabnow will inspect the asphalt roads and determine which roads should be done and include Hobart Township with the surrounding Townships that are going out for seal coating bids.

R Sonnenberg gave a Fire Board report. The Fire Department has received a DNR grant, has paid off both trucks, will be taking \$2000 per year out of the general fund to put in the truck fund, will be looking for a new pumper truck and when one is found, trade off/sell the existing pumper truck and jaws of life truck. The proposed increase to the budget will be 2%. The audit meeting is scheduled for 1/21/14 and the annual meeting is scheduled for 2/4/14.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
