Discussion was held on what it would cost to gravel the portion of Gorman's Road. Hockett will get back to Gorman on this issue. Discussion was held on what work would be done at the intersection of W Lake Seven Road and Lake Seven Trail before the road could be shaped for dust guard. Rocks are to be hauled in by Wymer Lake to prevent further boat launching.

Stabnow will get quotes for updating road signs.

Locations and times were discussed for the Otter Tail County Transportation Open House Meetings and Summer Short Courses.

Steve Moe addressed some dead trees on township property and would like to remove them, at his own expense, for the wood. The Board agreed to allow him to remove the trees, at his own expense and risk and allow him to keep the wood.

Stabnow gave an update on the Little MacDonald/Paul Lake outlet process and pursuing the shifting of the road on Edna town line road by Ackling's corner.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board. Hockett adjourned the meeting.
