

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting
July 14, 2015**

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 2015 meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Mike Opat, Moore Engineering gave an update on the Little Macdonald LID project. He explained how things are progressing, what stages the planning is in and the permitting process. Opat stated that they have been in contact with most of the land owners along the affected route and are trying to address their concerns. Opat has been staying in contact with Stabnow, who indicated that the TWP is possibly interested in doing some road work along this area in conjunction with this project. To better address the concerns of the affected farmers, it would be ideal to bury the pipe in the actual driving surface of the road.

At the end of the update, the Supervisors felt that all affected landowners should be invited to the next meeting to hear the updates, get their concerns addressed and determine what road work the Township should proceed with. Opat will provide the addresses to the Clerk to mail out notices.

The County has informed the Township that there is one parcel of land that is up for the tax forfeit sale and the County is looking for the Township to pass a resolution to allow the County to sell the parcel to the adjoining land owner. D Sonnenberg made the resolution to allow the County to sell the parcel to the adjoining landowner, as the adjoining landowner would have the only benefit of this parcel. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The District 9 Meeting will be held in Cormorant on August 17, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

Road were discussed, updates were given on the work being done on West Lake 7 Road, which is needed before dust guard can be applied. A dust guard request was received from Sannes, which the Board will review the road to determine whether or not more dust guard should be applied in the area of the request. Discussion was held regarding the graveling of Black Diamond Road, which portion Gorman will be graveling and which portion Hobart will be graveling.
