

Hobart Township Monthly Meeting
September 8, 2015

Present: Kathy Glawe, Debi Moltzan, Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ray Sonnenberg, Marv Heisler and Kurt Janu.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. The agenda was considered. D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the agenda with the following additions: Lake 7 Record keeping and Phil Thomas funeral. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the August 2015 minutes with the correction of 25 CI to 25 CF per second. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Moltzan explained that the Lake 7 Lake Association has contacted her with a request to store their lake association records at the town hall, with the stipulation that the Township would not be held liable for the records. Discussion was held regarding the request. D Sonnenberg made a motion to allow the lake association to keep their records at the hall with the stipulation that the Township not be held responsible for the records and that the lake association furnish a locked storage cabinet/file for the records and be the sole holders of the key. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Phil Thomas, former Treasurer recently passed away. Discussion was held regarding sending a memorial. Consensus of the Board was that a plant would be sent as a memorial and the Board members would pay for the plant out of their own money, not Township funds.

Updates were given on brushing, road ditch mowing, repairing the bridge on Wymer Lake, crack sealing and fixing corners. J& J Concrete will provide an estimate for fixing the Wymer Lake Bridge. Hockett made a motion to pursue a cost analysis on the Wymer Lake Bridge work. R Sonnenberg second. Hockett made a motion have Brent Newling crack seal and fix corners. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried. Shoulder work along Fairy Lake was discussed. R Sonnenberg made a motion to follow the engineer's recommendation to fill in the hollow spots in the road shoulders along Fairy Lake. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Perham EMS meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 28, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
