

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting
January 12, 2016**

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. The agenda was considered and with no additions to the agenda, D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 2015 meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

D Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. R Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Upcoming meetings were discussed. February 2, 2016 will be the annual Fire Department Meeting. The tentative date for the Budget and Audit Meeting is scheduled for February 25, 2016 and the March monthly meeting is tentatively scheduled for March 3, 2016. Notices will be posted once the dates are confirmed. The dates may change due to previous commitments by Board Members.

Rod Boyer expressed concerns that he felt that the website is weak and needed to contain more information, such as agendas, treasurer's reports and disbursements. Boyer also expressed concerns about this year's snow removal.

Discussion was held regarding the website and the clerk and treasurer will check to see what and how things can be added to the website to give the residents more information without too much additional maintenance cost for the website.

Discussion was also held regarding the winter maintenance of the road and the need to remove brush and trees along the Wymer Lake roads. Once it is known when brush and tree removal will be done, the residents along this area will be notified.

Discussion was held regarding removing of the brush from the ditches that have already been cut and the possibility of spraying the brush this spring. The contractors will be contacted by the supervisors to discuss the options.

R Sonnenberg stated that the last air pac payment has been made and the fire department will be reapplying for a grant to help pay for the air pacs. If the grant is received, the money will be set aside for future use.

Stabnow stated that he is working on paving estimates and will have them ready by the annual meeting.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
