

**Hobart Township Monthly Meeting  
October 11, 2016**

**Present:** Kathy Glawe, Ray Sonnenberg, Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Debi Moltzan, Rick Sonnenberg, Gary Krause, Rod Boyer, Chuck Walton, and Roger Olson.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 2016 meeting. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

R Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the disbursements as read. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Chuck Walton stated that he was there in place of the Anderson's and Delta Daggett in regards to \Good Oak Loop and Good Oak Trail and the paving project and wanted to know what the Board had decided as far as how much they would contribute to the project. Walton also stated that there is another option of using Otta Seal instead of asphalt. R Sonnenberg stated that the road in question is a dead end road and not a through road and these types of projects are usually not considered for dead end roads unless the residents pay for the project. R Sonnenberg further stated that Otta Seal is not being used much anymore and he would not say whether or not this type of material would be considered without the TWP's engineer's report, which has not yet been received. Walton stated that maintenance would be cheaper on a tarred road versus a gravel road. D Sonnenberg stated that maintenance is about the same when you consider in preparation, seal coating, etc. D Sonnenberg further stated that the TWP has never used tax payer money to initially pave a road, but public money is used to maintain the road once paved.

After much discussion regarding costs of asphalt, Otta Seal, gravel, dust guard and maintenance, the Board reiterated that they cannot take any type of position until they have a report from the TWP engineer.

Rod Boyer questioned why the vendor list has not been published on the website. Glawe and Moltzan both explained that until a way is found to convert the CTAS reports into something compatible with the website, they won't be posted; the cash control statements are posted.

Sand/salt mixture for the upcoming winter was discussed. The County has sent out a resolution to allow the TWPs to buy sand/ salt through the County. R Sonnenberg made a motion to pass a resolution to buy the sand/salt from the County. D Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Annual Meeting for EOT Townships is October 25, 2016 at Deer Creek. Election is November 8, 2016.

R Sonnenberg gave an update on the Fire Department in regards to working on the new percentages which the townships will have to base the fire protection on. R Sonnenberg stated that he had met with Newling regarding putting up a guard rail by the bridge to prevent people driving onto the lake and using the TWP right of way as a public access. A quote will be submitted to the Town Board.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
